1. intracellular (adj)	Existing or located within the cells	An increase in intracellular calcium caused some distress.
2. intra-dermal (adj)	Within the layers of the skin	The intra-dermal injection was part of the allergy test.
3. intra-galactic (adj)	Occurring within a galaxy	Intra-galactic travel within the Milky Way may someday be common place.
4. intra-mural (adj)	Involving students within the same school	The intra-mural soccer team played only within Montpelier.
5. intra-nasal (adj)	Within the nose	The procedure involved intra-nasal surgery.
6. intra-ocular (adj)	Situated or existing within the eye	The intra-ocular lens altered the person eyesight.
7. intra-personal (adj)	Existing or occurring within your own mind; relates to the internal aspects of a person, especially emotions	Her intra-personal skills meant she understood her emotions and strengths/weaknesses very well.
8. intra-psyche (adj)	Within the mind	The patient suffers from an intra-psyche conflict.
9. intra-venous (adj)	Within the veins	Hospitals commonly use intra-venous tubes to administer fluids and medications to patients.
10. intra-state	Confined within the state	An intra-state business development plan would focus on increasing jobs here in Vermont.
