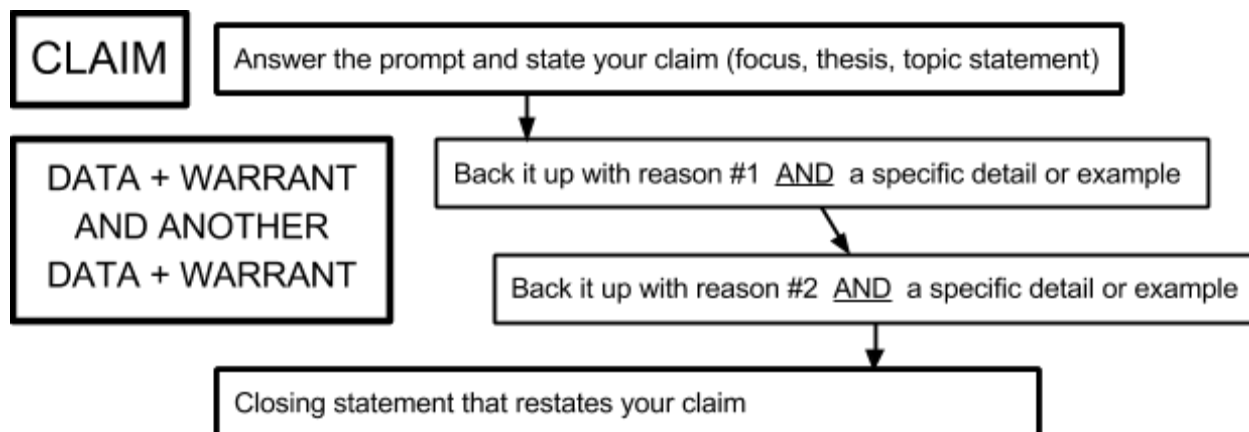


Basic Paragraph Organizer:

Basic 5 Paragraph Organizer:

Introductory Paragraph

This is where you **restate the topic** given to you and give some context about your essay's purpose. You will need to give three examples to support the topic you are writing about. These examples will help you develop the subsequent paragraphs. It is easier to list three subtopics and write about them in paragraphs 1, 2, and 3, than it is to pick one sub topic and write three paragraphs on that one subtopic.
