This project will count for two grades: one in writing and one in speaking and listening. GUMS, or writing conventions such as spelling, punctuation, and capitalization, will be graded under the language standard but will be assigned a lower 'weight' (.25) rather than a full grade. This is not a formal research paper with the end product being an essay. The writing will consist of short, descriptive, fact-laden sentences to accompany visuals. Visuals **MUST** be included in the project. These are projects may be **individual**, **pair or a group of three**.
